



4. RCS bookings

Only certain matters may be booked in RCS.

TIP

Matters not available for booking in RCS can be scheduled at the appropriate CMO or court location. To reschedule a trial, the file must be brought forward for an adjournment application before a Provincial Court Judge.

Note: Special prosecutions and Regulatory matters can be booked in RCS.

On file ownership matters where a Crown prosecutor is assigned, all counsel must agree on the date prior to booking a court appearance.



Booking Tips

- In file ownership matters, all counsel must agree on the date prior to booking a court appearance.
- Low complexity and short domestic violence matters do not require consent of Crown prior to booking a court appearance.
- All files related to the substantive matter should be booked at the same time when applicable.
- A matter is booked only once.
- When a Designation of Counsel is required, it **must** be filed before booking on RCS.
- When the accused is in custody, ensure the <Accused in Custody> is checked in the Requirements section.
- For matters that have been pre-booked, bring a printed copy of the confirmation email to the next appearance for confirmation of the pre-booked date.
- For matters requiring a pre-trial conference (PTC), select a PTC date, in addition to the Trial or Preliminary Hearing date.

Minimum Time Allowed to Remotely Book a Case

You must book a minimum of two (2) clear business days prior to next court appearance. Once the booking is complete, the matter is brought forward from the previous date to the new remotely scheduled date.

Pre-Booking

A pre-booking is a matter that is booked with two clear business days up to 8 am on the date of the scheduled court appearance. Counsel must still appear in Court to confirm the date and provide a printed copy of the confirmation email.



Pre-booking (Edmonton only)

The Available Dates screen provides additional dates requiring acknowledgement by counsel to appear at the next court appearance.

- The selection of these later dates **MUST** be approved by a Provincial Court Judge and the selection of files/accused must still appear on the next upcoming court date.

When pre-booking remotely, check off the "Pre-Book" checkbox.

- The next court appearance for any of the selected files/accused for this booking have a next appearance within the minimum number of days required. Counsel is still required to appear at the next court date indicated for these files/accused to confirm this booking. Crown attendance is required to confirm date if next date is not located at the Case Management Office.

The matter is not brought forward, and counsel is required to appear at the next court date. Counsel must provide a printed copy of the confirmation email at the next court appearance date.

Booking for other Court locations

Matters must be scheduled for trial or hearing in the city where the charges originate.



Same Day Appearances

8 a.m. is the cut-off for same day court appearances. The following error will display:

ERROR: THIS BOOKING IS NOT ALLOWED. IT IS AFTER 8:00 A.M.

Note: if you start the booking prior to 8 a.m. and do not finish the booking process until after 8:00 a.m., you will receive the following error message:

ERROR: THIS BOOKING IS NOT ALLOWED. IT IS AFTER 8:00 A.M.

Designation of Counsel

It is extremely important that on indictable matters the Designation of Counsel be filed before remote booking.

Required for Indictable Offence Matters only.

A booking may be subject to cancellation should the court office not have the Designation of Counsel on file.



Booking Types in RCS

The following table lists all of the possible combination of bookings in RCS. Hybrid offences/absolute jurisdiction must have a Crown election to be booked.
